This runway is located on the Icy Hill chase, just as you start climbing up the hill. There's a big rock about 10 metres in the bush to the left of the trail and it is said that Leo watched there often and shot several deer from that spot.

Leo (although we called him Leo, his official name was Edward Leo) is fondly remembered by the hunters for his kindness, quick wit and love of hunting. James P was one of his favourite uncles and, over the years, whenever he was home visiting his own parents and relatives, he never missed an opportunity to visit James and share a wee drink.
